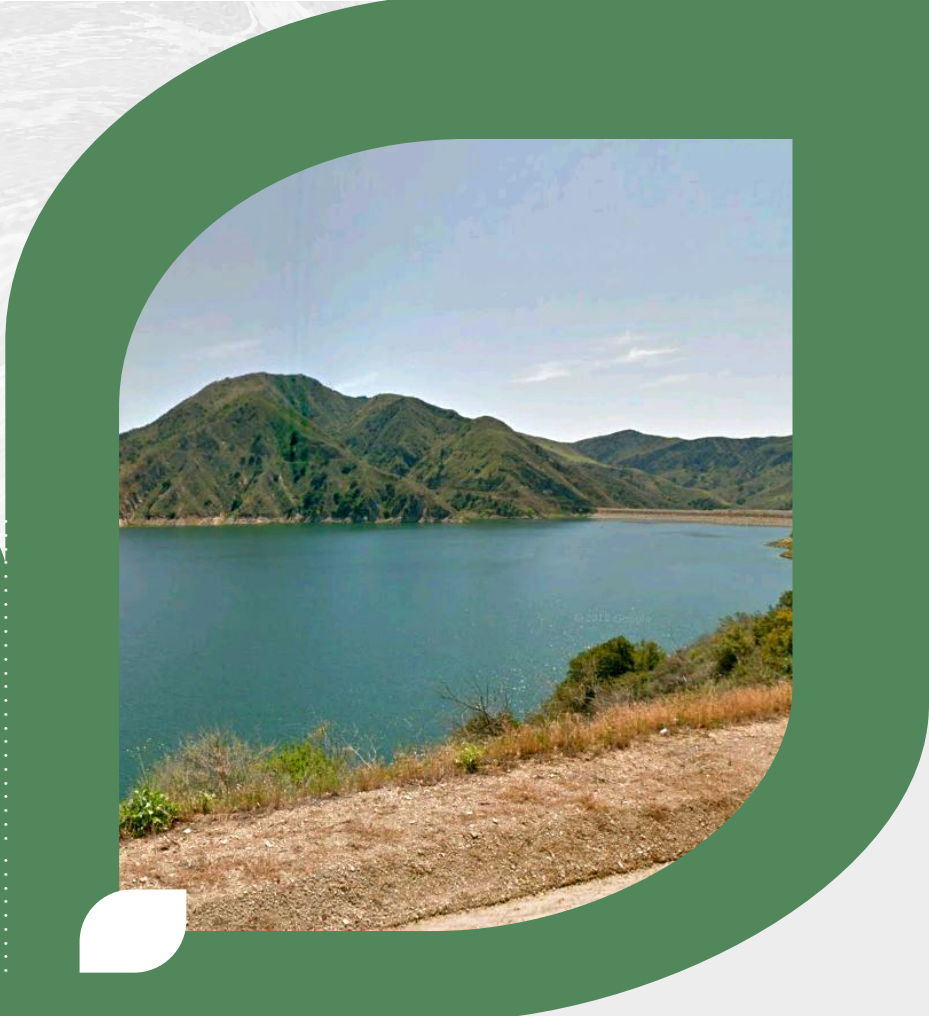

has devoted much of his career to overseeing UWCD's ground-water recharge facilities and conservation releases from Lake Piru to the downstream ground-water basins. He is currently working on the Habitat Conservation Plan for the Freeman Diversion, which covers several endangered species such as the steelhead trout. Mr. McEachron also oversees imports of UWCD's State Water, including the additional Article 21 water that was secured in recent years, and provides input on storage/recharge agreements with neighboring water districts.

brought his expertise in aqueous geochemistry, groundwater modeling, and the effects of timing and magnitude of rainfall on recharge of aquifers to UWCD in 2015, where he has focused on evaluating the sustainability of the groundwater basins of the Santa Clara River and Oxnard Plain and helping to develop water-supply projects that can lead us to a resilient future.
